



Opportunity for YRE students to participate in ICSE 2021, India, as Reporters

The **3rd International Conference on Sustainability Education (ICSE)** is being Virtually organized on **9-10 September 2021** between **15:00 – 17:00 hrs (GMT+5:30)** by Mobius Foundation in partnership with some of the key environmental organizations, Climate Reality Project, UNESCO, Centre for Environment Education (CEE), Foundation for Environmental Education (FEE, Copenhagen), The Energy and Resource Institute (TERI), Earth Day Network, WWF India, and others.

The year 2021 marks the launch of the United Nations Decade on Ecosystem Restoration (2021 – 2030). The first day of the ICSE 2021 will therefore focus on the theme **“Education for Ecosystem Restoration”**. The deliberations of the 2nd day will be devoted to the theme of **“Climate Literacy”**, in view of the urgent need to create enlightened citizenry for concrete action on climate change. This is being organized in continuation to the **‘Climate Literacy Conclave for South Asia’** which was organized by Mobius Foundation with Climate Reality Project and Earth Day Network to mark the 51st anniversary of the Earth Day on 22nd April 2021.

We are looking for YRE participants between **16-24 years** to join the conference sessions and report on these through writing stories. They will be expected to also do video interviews with some of the speakers at the conference. Additional responsibility for the YRE will be Rapporteurship for the session they are participating in.

The programme empowers young people to take an educated stand on environmental issues they feel strongly about and gives them a platform to articulate these issues through the media of writing, photography, or video.
